In all of my walks, I did not see God.





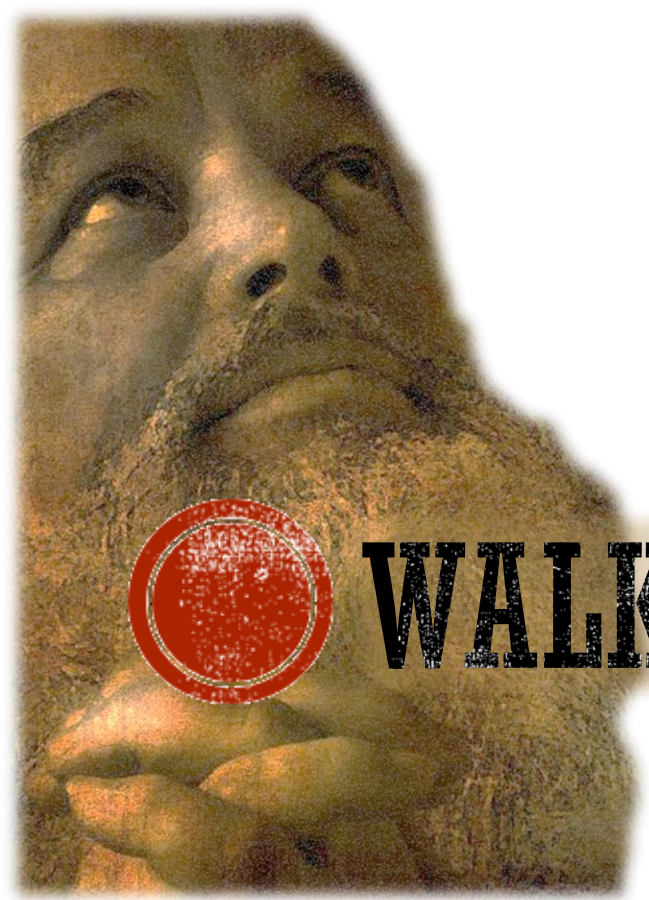
WALKING WITH GOD

Genesis 4:26

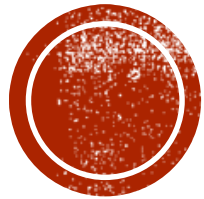


WALKING WITH GOD

Genesis 6:9

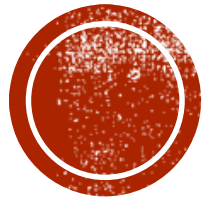


WALKING WITH GOD

Genesis 17:1



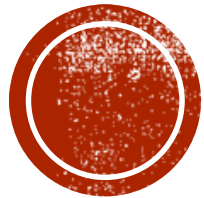

Exhortation to Solomon

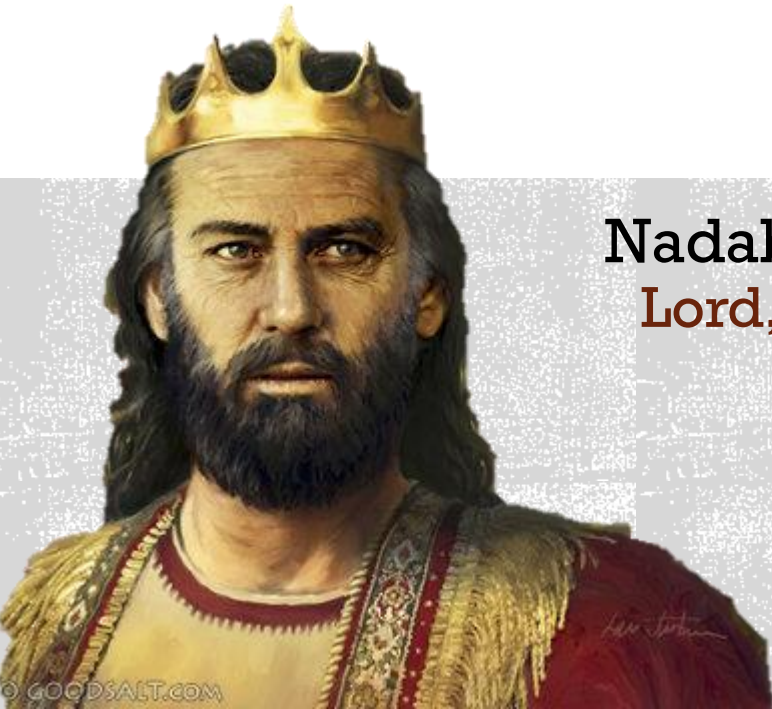
“Be strong, therefore, and show yourself a man. Keep the charge of the Lord your God, to **walk in His ways.**”

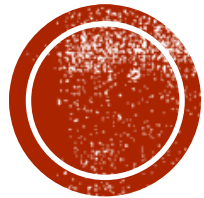


Nadab: “He did evil in the sight of the Lord, and **walked in the way of his father.**”

WALKING WITH GOD

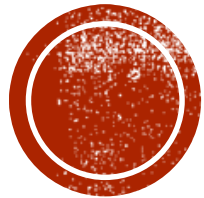

By following Jesus, we in turn walk with God.



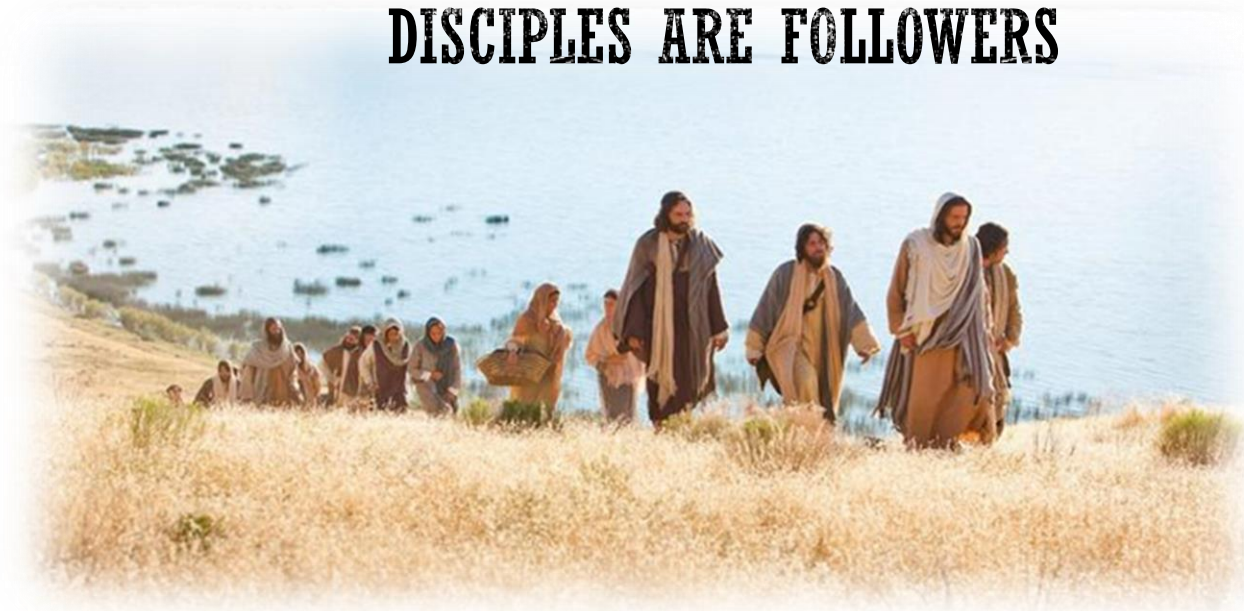

DISCIPLES ARE FOLLOWERS



FOLLOWING JESUS

Follow –

walk the same road

❑ accompany, attend, follow

❑ to cleave steadfastly to one, conform wholly to his example, in living and if need be in dying also (Thayers)





■ Disciples **Defined**

John 8:31

So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, “If you continue in My word, then you are truly **disciples** of Mine.”

DISCIPLES ARE LEARNERS

‘listening, watching, and experiencing’

Luke 6:40 –

“A pupil is not above his teacher; but everyone, after he has been fully trained, will be like his teacher.”

DISCIPLE DEFINED

Disciple - mathétés: a disciple; a learner, a pupil

- ❑ from *math-*, the “*mental effort* needed to think something through”
- ❑ properly, a learner; a disciple, a follower of Christ who learns the doctrines of Scripture and the lifestyle they require





■ The Path of Discipleship

1. Disciples **leave** in order to **follow**
2. Disciples follow in order to **learn**
3. Disciples learn in order to **live like**.
4. Disciples live like to **live with** Him.

REQUIREMENTS

“If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me”
