

"Save me, O Lord, from lying lips and from deceitful tongues."


Isaiah 2:4

742 BC

The Prophecy of the Virgin Birth

Isaiah 7

Combined Attack by an Alliance of Israel and Syria (7:1-9; 2 Kings 16)

We flash forward from Isaiah's call about 742 BC to a prophecy from a later time, somewhere between 736 (when Ahaz took the throne) and 734 (when Assyria laid siege to Damascus

- > Assyria, under Tiglath-pileser
- > Syria (RSV, KJV) or Aram (NIV, NRSV) ruled by Rezin
- > Israel (the northern kingdom) ruled by Pekah
- > Judah (the southern kingdom) ruled by Ahaz




Chapter **ELEVEN**
